Library:

Supt. Duling went over the High School Additions and Renovations to the High School. The project is scheduled to be completed August 1, 2016. The board is looking in to more grants. He discussed and presented the Chrome books used by the students.

Village Board:

Trustee Troutman talked about the pool committee and that Nate Rice was staying on as manager. Trustee Gilroy gave a report on the Property Committee. The committee is currently working on updates to the playground and restroom renovation at Cutter's Grove Park. The restroom renovation will include cameras in hopes to prevent vandalism. Street Scape in phases and possibly new Christmas lighting. Trustee Sutherland gave a report from the Finance Committee. He reported the Village is finally starting to receive some funds from the State. He also brought up the need to repair Town Avenue to Craig Street. Trustee Haley reported the Village is in the process of setting up the new budget and hopes to make some changes in the upcoming fiscal year. President Stahl gave an overview of businesses that used TIF grants this past fiscal year. Princeville State Bank, Princeville Pharmacy, Cordis and Cordis, Library, Akron-Princeville Fire Dept. He discussed the upgrade of S. Walnut Avenue, the repair and repainting of the south water tower, street seal coating. He also reported that once in awhile some unplanned maintenance comes up, for example winter is tough on older water lines, which continues to be a problem with an aging infrastructure. There are a lot of homes for sale right now in

Princeville, seems to be a little down turn in the Economy. The Village has issued a building permit for a Dollar General Store and it should be operational in late summer.

PCA: Report given by Julie Delbridge. PCA meets every 2nd Monday of the month at the Village Hall, public is invited. Julie gave a report on the events the PCA holds, Heritage Days, Community Awareness Day, and Holiday Homecoming. They are currently working on a welcoming basket for new residents.
