

Princeville Village Board Minutes

March 2, 2015

7:30 p.m.

The Princeville Village Board met on the above date at the Village Hall. President Stahl called the meeting to order with the following members answering roll: Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, and Haley. Trustees Gilroy and Carton were absent. A quorum was present for the meeting. Notice of the meeting and the agenda were sent and received in a timely manner. Others present were Village Clerk Mercer, Treasurer Hofer, and Municipal Code Officer, Sullivan. Superintendent of Public Works was absent.

Police Reports: Deputy Groeper reported the issuance of 4 ordinance tickets and Treasurer Hofer reported the fines have been paid.

There was an attempted theft of a lawn mower at German-Bliss, with an arrest made.

Trustee Troutman mentioned an issue with parents driving recklessly while dropping off their children at the Grade School. This is a major concern for safety of children who walk to school. This will be monitored.

Approve Minutes as published: Trustee Troutman made a motion to approve the minutes as published, with a second by Trustee Haley. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes, no nays, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Financials distributed by Treasurer Hofer and reviewed by the board. Trustee Sutherland made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, with a second by Trustee Koller. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes, no nays, motion carried.

Paying of February bills and Additional bills: President Stahl added another invoice to the list for the annual Web service in the amount of \$300.00. Trustee Koller made a motion to pay the February bills and additional bills, with a second by Trustee Sutherland. President Stahl roll call vote. Trustees Sutherland,

Troutman, Koller, and Haley voting aye. Trustees Gilroy and Carton absent.
Motion carried.

PCA: Julie Delbridge the PCA meeting will be March 9, 2015. A teen band has been scheduled for Thursday evening of Heritage Days. Hometown Talent Show on Friday and another band scheduled for Saturday evening. There are many events scheduled at the Museum in March. Sonja Stalter, Princeville High School After Prom Representative to address board: Sonja was seeking donation to help with the After Prom to be held at the High School. Trustee Koller made a motion to donate \$600.00 and 10 one day pool passes. Second by Trustee Troutman. President Stahl, roll call vote. Trustees Sutherland, Troutman, Koller and Haley voting aye. No nays. Gilroy and Carton absent. Motion carried.

Report from Municipal Code Officer: Dan Sullivan has been working with the Village Attorney getting everything in order for the sale of the High Street property that was acquired by the Village. MCO continues to work with the Village attorney on the Cannabis ordinances.

He has addressed some property code violations on Evans Street. Also checked on an abandoned car and a boat on Woertz Road. There was no issue with the boat at this time, he will re-check in April.

MCO will begin updating obsolete ordinances and removing them from the books and website.

Committee Reports: Pool committee has met to start working on the 2015 Pool Season. Life guard applications are being accepted. The committee will meet again in late March to go thru the applications. Guards will be hired and fitted for uniforms in April. Chairman of Pool Committee Trustee Troutman, will present the Pool wages and salaries in writing to the Board for approval. The vending service will be used again in 2015 as it saved on wages and received a small income in commission. Plan is to open the pool for Memorial Day weekend, but close during the week after, as school will still be in session.

Building Permits: None. The work currently being done at the Old Wash Tub does not require a permit.

Report from Supt of Public Works: The Superintendent was absent.

Any Other Business to be brought before the board:

Troutman Park 5k is scheduled for May 16th, 2015 with pancake breakfast and other activities. The Foundation plans to raffle a car in August. Dean Troutman

has decided to "Walk" the State of Illinois as a fund raiser. He plans to begin his walk on April 28th and ending in Mt. Vernon on July 9, 2015. He is being assisted with his walking plan by students of the Princeville School District.

German-Bliss will be celebrating their 75th year in business, April 11, 2015. The Lion's Club will be serving pancakes and sausage. Alan Jackson will be present. Possibly the Governor and other Senators and Congressmen.

Trustee Sutherland received a phone call from Bill German. Mr. German would like to praise and thank the employees of the Village for doing such a fine job with the snow removal this year.

Adjournment: Trustee Koller made a motion to adjourn, with a second by Trustee Troutman. President Stahl voice vote. All ayes, no nays. Motion carried. President Stahl adjourned the meeting at 8.30 pm.
