

Village of Princeville Regular Board Meeting

Tuesday, September 16, 2008

7:30 PM

Princeville Village Hall

The Village Board meeting was held at the above time and place.

The meeting was called to order by President Stahl at 7:30 PM with the following Trustees answering present; Sutherland, Rasmussen, Troutman, Koller, Barrington and Knapp. A quorum was present for the meeting. Others present were Village Clerk Rasmussen, Supt. of Public Works Gardner, Sec. /Treas. Hofer and Police Officer Fritz. Notice of the meeting and the Agenda were sent and received in a timely manner.

Police report: complaint of telephone harassment was filed; someone drove thru the lawn of a Church yard; Princeville Tap was warned about state smoking violations; Main St and Walnut Ave a Battery occurred; a small motorcycle was found and not claimed by the owner; and several Traffic tickets and a resulting DUI arrest was affected.

Gary and Marsha Peterson speaks to the board: The Petersons are asking to be paid for the sewer blow-back which occurred when a sewer cleaning company blew raw sewage and water into their basement while clearing a plugged Village sewer line. Motion by Rasmussen with a second by Knapp to pay the Peterson's in the amount of \$1040.96 reimbursement. Roll call vote. Sutherland, Rasmussen, Troutman, Koller, Barrington and Knapp all voting aye. No nays. Motion passed. The Sewer Cleaning Co and the Village Insurance Companies both denied any claim for this occurrence.

Jean Mertens to speak to the board: There still seems to be vehicles speeding on E Main St and there are a number of children riding bikes, skate boards and scooters in the street, even after dark. The residences were given to the board and the police officer is to make a home visit to warn the parents of the safety needed; as some cars and trucks don't see the children in the streets.

Ron Streitmatter had a petition about the speeding on N Santa Fe Ave as well. The petition wants the 25 MPH limit moved north of the Alcoa Building.
