Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting
Tuesday, August 21, 2012 **7:30PM** **Princeville Village Hall**

The Village Board meeting was held at the above time and place. The meeting was called to order by President Stahl at 7:30PM with the following Trustees answering present; Troutman, Koller, Delbridge, Gilroy, and Gill. Sutherland was absent. A quorum was present for the meeting. Others present for the meeting were Supt. Gardner, Village Clerk Rice, and Sec. /Treas. Hofer.

Amend the agenda to include, Consider & Vote on invoice for blacktop on N. Town curb & driveway and Richard Sennett to speak to Board.

Police Report- Arrest made for domestic abuse and subject violated bond after release. Report of juvenile taking 6ridalin and called suicide hotline. The Officer is watching stop signs. There will be extra patrol around school during pick up/drop off times to watch stop signs and speed. There is a request for school zone speed signs around grade school and high school.

PCA: no report at this time

Committee Reports:

Pool- The pool is closed for the season and winterizing will begin.

Sidewalks- Residents on Main St. were curb/sidewalk repair was done wanted to know if Village would be reseeding grass. Supt. states it will be reseeded in next week or two. Blacktopping will be finished tomorrow.

Parks- Weeding is needed in front of Village Hall. The outlet in gazebo needs to be taken out and replaced.

Consider & Vote on ordinance adding video gaming regulations to the Village Code- Motion by Koller, second by Delbridge to approve ordinance adding video gaming regulations to the Village Code. Roll Call Vote. President Stahl, Troutman, Koller, Delbridge, Gilroy, and Gill voting aye. No nays. Sutherland absent. Motion passed

Building Permits:

None at this time.

Supt. of Public Works Report: Seneca Foods has started. The streets are to be blacktopped by tomorrow. The post office is happy with the transition made with asphalt. MFT program will seal-coat streets next Wednesday. The paperwork regarding the energy program was turned into the courthouse. The Supt. and Sec/Treas. Will determine all residents eligible. Supt. spoke with Larry Wigand and the trucks will not be entering alleyway due to high liability and garbage will be put out to street. Russ Hyde went to courthouse over zoning issues brought up at previous meetings. Supt. met with Arrowhead and Fox Services and they recommend a calcium hypochlorite system. Quote will be given on heaters and maintenance. The pool needs to not be drained due to others having cracks in liner after draining pool for winter. Quote will be needed on pool safety cover.

Richard Sennett- Spoke to board to offer his services(architects and land surveyors) out of their Galesburg office.

Consider & Vote on invoice- Motion by Troutman, second by Delbridge to approve \$3,700.00 to R. Potter Paving & Sealcoating paid at prevailing wages.

Other business- Past Due water Accounts were passed out. Sue will call Tom Pfeffer for a legal letter to be sent out to all delinquent accounts and updated Past Due Accounts will be made available once.
