

**Village of Princeville**  
**Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**  
**Monday July 7, 2014      7:30 pm      Princeville Village Hall**

The Village Board Meeting was held at the above time and place. The meeting was called to order by President Stahl at 7:30 pm with the following Trustees answering present: Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Gilroy, Carton and Haley. A quorum was present for the meeting. Notice of the meeting and agenda were sent and received in a timely manner. Others present were Treasurer Hofer, MCO Dan Sullivan, Supt. of Public Works Gardner and Clerk Mercer.

**Police Report:** NA

**Approve Minutes as published:** Trustee Troutman made a motion to approve June Minutes as published. Second by Trustee Gilroy. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes, no nays, motion carried.

**Approve Treasurer's report:** Report distributed by Treasurer Hofer, reviewed and discussed by the board. Trustee Sutherland made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, with a second by Trustee Carton. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes, no nays, motion carried.

**Paying of June Bills:** June bills reviewed by the board. Trustee Troutman made a motion to approve June bills, Second by Trustee Haley. President Stahl, roll call vote. Trustee Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Gilroy, Carton and Haley voting aye. No nays. Motion carried.

Trustee Carton questioned the electronic recycling that was included in the new garbage contract. President Stahl will contact PDC to get it set up and MCO Sullivan will work with the School District to tentatively schedule the events for September 6, 2014 and May of 2015.

**Summer Rice to speak to board about dangerous dogs:** A neighbor's dog has attacked the Rice's dog three times. The dog breaks its leash when tied out and has gone thru a window to get out. PAWS have been contacted, and a Police report filed. PAWS have declared the dog dangerous, but not vicious. The owners of the dog do have a court date. Mrs. Rice would like to see the village enact a dangerous dog ordinance, similar to the one of Peoria Heights. The board will take the suggestion into consideration. MCO Dan Sullivan will draft a letter of concern, with President Stahl's signature to voice the concerns of the Village of Princeville and the Rice's to the State's Attorney prior to the court date. Mrs. Rice thanked the Board and President Stahl for their help.

**PCA:** Heritage days went well. Last meeting of the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission is Tuesday July 8, 2014, 6:00 PM at the museum. Julie Delbridge is working on getting a cost for placing all the ordinances on the Village Of Princeville website. She will let the board know the cost at the next board meeting, July 22, 2014. Community Coffee will be held July 9, 2014 at the museum. A troop of boy scouts from Peoria has contacted Julie in

regards to camping overnight for the Heritage Harvest Festival. They would like to use the property behind the School House. The Troop will carry their own insurance, and will be camping in tents. There would be one adult chaperone for each scout, making a total of 50 campers. Trustee Troutman made a motion to allow the Scout Troop from Peoria to camp overnight for the Heritage Harvest Festival, on Village of Princeville property, July 25<sup>th</sup> and leaving on July 26, 2014. Second by Trustee Haley. President Stahl, voice vote, all ayes, no nays. Motion carried.

**Consider and Vote on Annual Appropriation Ordinance and Estimate of Revenues:**

Trustee Sutherland made a motion to approve the Annual Appropriation Ordinance and Estimate of Revenues for the fiscal year May 1, 2014 thru April 30, 2015. Second by Trustee Carton. President Stahl, roll call vote. Trustee Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Gilroy, Carton and Haley voting aye. No nays. Motion carried.

**Committee Reports:** Pool Committee – meeting will be held July 16, 2014 at 6:00 PM at the Aquatic Center. Golf Cart committee met, adapted the Chillicothe Ordinance to meet their recommendations.

**Any action needed to be taken regarding committee reports:** Board to review Golf Cart Ordinance.

**Consider and Vote on Golf Cart Ordinance:** Trustee Koller made a motion to approve the Golf Cart Ordinance for the Village of Princeville. Second by Trustee Haley. President Stahl, roll call vote. Trustee Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Gilroy, Carton and Haley voting aye. No nays. Motion carried.

**Building Permits:** None

**Report from Superintendent of Public Works:** South Water Tower has a leak, will be repaired in the morning with a cost of \$4,500.00. There will be approximately two-hundred feet of sidewalks replaced this summer. This work is being completed by Village employees and a Community Service helper. Potter Seal-coating repaired a section of street by Casey's and South Street. The South Street repair was necessary due to a prior water leak. Superintendent has a meeting scheduled with the County in regards to the repairs needed on Cottage Grove. It was necessary to sewer pump during the heavy rain fall, for approximately 4 hours. Dwayne Pridemore has been helping out, and filling in for Russ Hyde, who has been on vacation. Peoria County has been putting up new stop signs within the Village. The Village has also been working with residents in Ostrom Meadows that have had water problems in their backyards. The maintenance shop roof will soon be painted. A couple of Water hydrants will be replaced this summer. Street and crosswalk striping will be completed prior to school resuming. IDOT is opening bids to resurface and upgrade Route 91 from Stark County line to the 4-way stop. Trustee Troutman asked if they would address the need of slower speed limit during the upgrade, the Superintendent will check on it.

Work continues on Aten Acres phase 6. Any interest of purchasing a lot should be directed to Cordis and Cordis, LLC.

**Any other business that needs to be brought before the board:** Troutman Park Foundation held its monthly meeting. Wayne Hermann was present to help out with the issues with neighboring residents and baseball. None of the neighboring residents attended the meeting, in which they were encouraged to do so by President Stahl and the Board of Trustees. The foundation will recommend to the Princeville Little League that the diamond be used by younger youth and girls' softball, as the balls will not travel so far.

**Adjournment:** Trustee Koller made a motion to adjourn, with a second by Trustee Troutman. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes, no nays. President Stahl adjourned the meeting at 9:10 pm.
