

**Village of Princeville  
Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**

**Monday, March 4, 2013**

**7:30p**

**Princeville Village Hall**

The Village Board Meeting was held at the above time and place. The meeting was called to order by President Stahl at 7:30PM with the following Trustees answering present; Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Delbridge, Gilroy, and Carton. A quorum was present for the meeting. Notice of the meeting and the Agenda were sent and received in a timely manner. Others present were Village Clerk Rice, Sec. /Treas. Sue Hofer, and Supt. of Public Works Gardner. Trustee Delbridge left meeting at 8:03 due to illness.

**Police Report-** There was a report of a ring taken and given away on Cottage Grove. There was a mailbox beaten up and a report of a vagrant spending the night in the laundry mat. Officer went to check it out but no person was found. There were 2 arrests made on warrants. There was an arrest made for attempted poisoning to two dogs, case is pending.

**Approval of Minutes as Published:** Motion by Troutman, second by Delbridge to approve minutes with amendment. Voice Vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion passed.

**Approval of Treasurers Report-** Motion by Sutherland, second by Carton to approve the Treasurers Report. Voice vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion passed.

**Paying of the Bills:** Motion by Troutman, second by Delbridge to approve to pay February bills and additional as presented. Roll call vote. Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Delbridge, Gilroy and Carton voting aye. No nays. Motion passed.

**Reports from Municipal Code Officer-** Officer reports he has made phone calls in regards to the recycling grant from Peoria County. Recycling is currently at 65%, but we are pushing for 100%. We will find out results for grant in May. There are plans for a disposal day, June 15, 2013, to be held at the high school. Electronics can be dropped off and Eagle will provide a recycling dumpster as well. The Main St. property went to court and was found in contempt. Resident paid partial and has two weeks to comply. There is a March 15, 2013 court date. A lien is prepared for the home, giving 30 days to pay, then will be filed. Home is in foreclosure.

**PCA Report-** The next PCA meeting is next Monday. They are waiting to hear about Easter Egg Hunt. There is a meeting Wednesday night at the Museum for the Princeville to Peoria St. Jude Run.

**Committee Reports-**

TIF- Had 1 application. Lillie M. Evans library is requesting \$52,256.44. Recommended Village pays \$25,000.00 reimbursement. Motion by Koller, second by Troutman to approve \$25,000.00 reimbursement for capital expenditures to Lillie M. Evans Library. Roll Call Vote. Sutherland, Troutman, Gilroy, and Carton voting aye. No nays. Koller abstain. Delbridge absent. Motion passed.

**Request for donation to PTO Turkey Noodle Dinner-** Summer Rice requests a donation of pool pass for summer fun basket to be donated at the PTO Turkey Noodle Dinner. Motion by Troutman, second by Carton to approve 1 Multi-Use Visit Pass to the Princeville Aquatic Center to be donated to PTO Turkey Noodle Dinner. Roll Call Vote. Sutherland, Troutman, Koller, Gilroy and Carton voting aye. No nays. Delbridge absent. Motion passed.

**Building permits:**

None at this time.

**Report from the Supt. of Works-** There was some trouble at the water plant. There was a leak at Ostrom Meadows that was fixed. Snow Removal being done. Russ will go to Dr. on Wednesday and will get note to work with restrictions.

**Other Business:** On March 1, 2013 there has only been 1 bid for Water Tower work. Bid opening will be March 18, 2013 and if bid is high, will reject and rebid in November. A letter was sent out to The Princeville Tap and VFW regarding the garbage containers. Wigand will provide one 6 ton container, thus replacing the 2 current containers. The only other option for the businesses would be to bag items and take to curb. There will be a 5K Run/Walk for Troutman Park. In regards to snow removal, Supt. would like residents to know that when it is snowing, snow is plowed to keep streets open and when snowing has stopped it is plowed again to the curb.

**Leave Regular Meeting and Enter Executive-** Motion by Troutman, second by Koller to leave the regular meeting and enter into executive session.

**Adjourn-** Motion by Koller, second by Troutman to adjourn meeting. President Stahl adjourned meeting at 9:19pm.
