**Consider & vote on Ordinance and Intergovernmental Agreement for TIF 1 money to APFPD-** Motion by Rasmussen, second by Sutherland to approve the Princeville TIF District 1 an ordinance approving and authorizing the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Princeville and Akron-Princeville Fire Protection District. #11-04-03. Roll Call Vote. Sutherland, Rasmussen, Barrington, and Delbridge voting aye. No nays. Troutman and Koller abstaining from vote. Motion passed.

**Patty O'Kane-** The fence that has gone up between alley(used by Main St. businesses) and Werneburg property has become a problem. Roll Call Vote. Sutherland, Rasmussen, Troutman, Koller, Barrington, and Delbridge voting aye. No nays. Motion passed She would like to know who owns alley and if fence can be there? The Village cannot find any papers for ownership on alleyway and will have to have it surveyed to find answer. Village also has Ameren looking into area due to possible gas line under fence. Motion by Koller, second by Troutman to have downtown area surveyed to find the boundary lines for Werneburg property and alleyway behind businesses on Main St. Voice Vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion passed.

**Supt. of Public Works Report:** Well project will start next week. Membranes are in and will

install next month. There will be a meeting with FEMA Thursday to go through bills and hours for snowfall for reimbursement. IEMA is requesting testing sewer plant for radiation waste due to water plant. Village will flush hydrants on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday and will be running tests to find out why water is corrosive. Have received quote for protective fencing for the Cutters Grove Park in the amount of \$7,000.00.

**Other business:** VFW would like to use of lot Route 90 and 91 on June 16, 17, and 18 for the use of beer tent. The lease would also be for 2 days prior and 2 days after for build up and tear down. Motion by Sutherland, second by Troutman to grant VFW a 7 day lease (June 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20) on the corner lot of Route 90 and Route 91. Voice Vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion passed.

Request was made for Village to implore the business owners to use the municipality lots for parking in order to free up parking spaces on Main St. Signs will be placed to designate parking and lines need to be placed in parking lot. Trustee Troutman states the Village is welcome to black pipe that is on his property in the NW corner.

Concern over the main gas line owned by Seneca Foods at end of Santa Fe. Seneca did agree to put up barrier and will speak with Wally.
