Supt. of Public Works Report: There was a water leak on Town Ave. near Brockway Hills, it was fixed and residents are on a boil order until Friday. Supt. has been in contact with sweeper dealer and there is a refurbished sweep the Supt. will schedule to look at. It is a Pelican and only has 4500 hours. The tank is a poly tank, but the hopper is steel. Some residents have noticed rusty water and while flushing hydrants, there is rusty water. Need to inject phosphate into supply to stop rust from infiltrating and will run tests. The pH meter was off and have received new meter (at no cost). At the last snow sidewalks were to be cleaned, however skid loader's battery dead, has been recharged for next snow.

Other business: Trustee Barrington was wondering if the Village could go paperless to reduce costs. Trustee Barrington will make list of possible paper/communication that could go paperless.
