

**Village of Princeville
Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**

Tuesday, May 18, 2010

7:30PM

Princeville Village Hall

The Village Board meeting was held at the above time and place. The meeting was called to order by President Stahl at 7:30PM with the following Trustees answering present; Sutherland, Rasmussen, Troutman, Koller, Barrington, and Delbridge. A quorum was present for the meeting. Others present for the meeting were Village Clerk Rice, Supt. of Public Works Gardner, Sect./Treas. Hofer, and Russ Hyde.

Police Report: There was a vehicle theft, arrest was made. The bars in the Village are being very cooperative.

Discussion of No Smoking Ban with restaurant & bar owner- The Village received letter from States Attorney Kevin Lyons regarding the No Smoking Act and enforcement thereof. President Stahl invited restaurant/bar owners to meeting to discuss, only VFW present.

Motion by Sutherland, second by Delbridge to table the No Smoking Ban Enforcement to a future meeting to decide on whether or not to enforce the No Smoking Ban with help of States Attorney Kevin Lyons. Voice Vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion passed.

Winning Communities: Shop Princeville Contest for Heritage Days was started today. Hub Tribute Dance to be held at Museum May 22, 2010. The Peoria Tourism had a charter bus out with a stop at the Princeville Heritage Museum.

Committee Reports:

Pool: Question as to when the new heater is to be installed and how long to heat pool. Chad will call, should only take 7-10 days. Paint at bottom of pool is chipping, crack will be fixed. A citizen called Trustee Troutman concerning multi-use pass. Citizen is concerned new pass will cost his family more than last years. Fred Boland has agreed to fix plumbing for free if Village agrees to pay for parts. Manager states would like shelves for pump house.

TIF: Application from Princeville Automotive was sent on to Steve Klein.

Codification: distributed five pages of material for committee to look over before next meeting. Online ordinance is free for first year, then \$500 per year. Next meeting will be Monday, June 7,2010 at 6:30pm.

Treasurers Report- The fiscal year is completed and transfers were made. Budget did well; general expenses and water were not over budget. The parts for well/pump can go through TIF with approval from Steve Klein.

Motion by Rasmussen, second by Troutman to approve Treasurers Report as presented. Roll Call Vote. Sutherland, Rasmussen, Troutman, Koller, Barrington, and Delbridge voting aye. No nays. Motion passed.

Other Business- Jim Colyott brought pictures in of water flow behind his residence located in Ostrom Meadows. President Stahl would like to meet with them and with engineer in order to let them know their options.

Seneca wants to donate money to the Village for use. Suggestion was made to have monies be used for recreational use such as lights installed for softball diamond.

Parks Committee would like police to patrol park area.

Idea of looking at new attorneys has been brought up for 3 months and Trustee Barrington would like to see it as an agenda item for next meeting.

Officer Breitbarth states he can/has been adjusting hours for Village needs.

The new "Wilson Building" owners need to come forward and notify Village of new ownership and plans for building.

The next Zoning Board meeting will be addressing special use permit for Cell Towers, variance for height, and application for building permit.

The employees of businesses downtown are still parking on Main St. causing less parking spaces for patrons. Village will send letters again to business owners reminding them of available municipal parking. There is a 2 hour parking limit and it will be enforced.
