

## **Village of Princeville Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**

**December 5, 2016                      7:00 p.m.**

The Princeville Village Board met on the above date and time at the Village Hall. President Stahl called the meeting to order with the following Trustees answering present: Sutherland, Troutman, Gilroy, Haley and Geiger. Trustee Koller was absent. A quorum was present for the meeting. Notice of the meeting and the agenda were sent and received in a timely manner. Also present was Superintendent of Public Works, Gardner.

**Approved minutes as published:** After a correction Trustee Gilroy made a **motion** to approve minutes as published, with a second by Trustee Sutherland. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion Carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Trustee Troutman made a **motion** to approve the Treasurer's report with a second by Trustee Haley. President Stahl, voice vote. All ayes. No nays. Motion carried.

**Paying of November Bills and additional bills:** Trustee Haley made a **motion** to approve the November bills and additional bills in the amount of \$19,678.49. Second by Trustee Geiger. President Stahl, roll call vote. Trustees Sutherland, Troutman, Gilroy, Haley and Geiger voting aye. Trustee Koller absent. No nays. Motion carried.

**MCO Report:** Dan gave the board members a printed report of what has been going on the past month. There were four completed violations. Two current and four new violations that he is working on. Dan and Deputy Groeper visited several homes on December 1. They placed a Notice to Abate sign on a residence that has been in violation.

**Police Report:** Deputy Groeper reported that there were several accidents, a hit and run accident, disorderly conduct report, firecrackers set off, an alarm set off at a residence and the Village Hall, a natural death, controlled substance arrest and a theft at the Dollar General Store. An old hand grenade was found at a residence and Peoria County police came and retrieved it.

**Committee Reports:** There were no committee reports.

**Building Permits:** Country Tradesman for Knobloch at 9501 W. Oertley Rd. – extension to garage.

**Report from the Superintendent of Public Works:** Chad reported that four stumps will be ground out on Friday. The leaf pickup is finished. Snow was plowed on Sunday.

**Any other business to be brought before the board:** Butch Gardner was present and reported that the Lions Club had a good turnout for the Santa Breakfast at the Firehouse on Saturday. The Akron-Princeville Ambulance building is almost complete. The Village Board will have a Christmas get together in January. The December 20<sup>th</sup> meeting will probably be cancelled unless something important comes up.
