**Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**  
**October 20, 2015      7:30PM**

The Princeville Village Board met on the above date and time at the Village Hall. Acting President Sutherland called the meeting to order as President Stahl was absent. The following members answering present: Troutman, Koller, and Haley. Trustee Gilroy and Carton were absent. A quorum was present for the meeting.
