

ORDINANCE NO. 19-09-04

ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE CODE CHAPTER 5.08.170 CLOSING HOURS FOR BUSINESSES WITH ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR LICENSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Princeville, Peoria County, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 5.08.170 of the Code of the Village of Princeville Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows (additions are indicated by underline; deletions by ~~strikeout~~):

5.08.170 CLOSING HOURS --SUNDAY

- A. ~~No person licensed hereunder as a retailer of alcoholic liquor shall sell, permit to be sold, or give away any alcoholic liquor between the hours of one a.m. and seven a.m. on weekdays and between the hours of one a.m. and twelve noon on Sundays.~~
- A. No person licensed hereunder as a retailer of alcoholic liquor shall sell, permit to be sold, or give away any alcoholic liquor between the hours of two a.m. and six a.m. seven days a week. All Village of Princeville alcoholic liquor license classes have operating hours of six (6) A.M. to two (2) A.M.
- B. It is unlawful to keep open for business or admit the public to any premises where the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises is licensed (other than as a restaurant, hotel or club) during the hours within the sale of alcoholic liquor is prohibited.
- C. No person other than a licensee of a licensed premises or any of his/her employees, while actually in the performance of their duties, shall be permitted to enter or remain upon the premises, nor shall any person consume any alcoholic liquor upon such premises, nor shall any alcoholic liquor be exposed upon such premises in any open individual serving container (including but not limited to , glasses or beer bottles), beyond (30) minutes after the prescribed closing time for such licensed premises.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby ordered to be published in pamphlet form by the Village Clerk and said Clerk is ordered to keep at least three (3) copies hereof available for public inspection in the future and in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. All previous ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded by the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
