VILLAGE OF PRINCEVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 11-11-06

AN ORDINANCE WHICH SUPERCEDES ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PRINCEVILLE WITH RESPECT TO PARKING WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS, THIS ORDINANCE HEREBY AMENDS SECTION 10.08.080 PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PRINCEVILLE, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS.

10.08.080 Parking Restrictions.

- C. Parking Vehicles on Private Property
- 1. It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicles, watercraft, trailers, recreational vehicles or anything else of a vehicular nature in the Village of Princeville unless it is parked on a paved hard surface including asphalt, concrete, brick or rocked material.
- 2. No paved surface may be added to a front yard or backyard, subsequent to the date of this Ordinance being approved, without approval from the Village Administrator or his designee.
