

ORDINANCE NO. 2020- 06 - 01

ORDINANCE CORRECTING PROVISION IN VILLAGE CODE  
ADDRESSING THE HOUSING OF ANIMALS ON PROPERTY IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village Board has previously amended the listing of animals that are not permitted to BE housed or stabled on property within the Village as provided under Section 6.04.060 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, in December 2018, the Village Board revised and updated the entire Title 6 of the Village Code, which addresses the keeping and handling of animals in the Village, including dogs and cats; and

WHEREAS, during the December 2018 update of Title 6 of the Village Code, Section 6.04.060 was inadvertently revised to reflect a prior version of Section 6.04.060 that did not expressly list the types of animals that are not permitted in on property in the; AND

WHEREAS, the Village Board now seeks to re-set the provisions of Section 6.04.060 of the Village Code to the intended language as initially established by Ordinance No. 15-07-03, as adopted in July 2015;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Princeville, Peoria County, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1. Section 060 of Title 6, Chapter 4 of the Village of Princeville Municipal Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

**6.04.060 Housing.**

*No person shall cause or allow any stable or place where any animal or poultry is or may be kept to become unclean or unwholesome, and it is unlawful to keep any live swine, pigs, hogs, poultry, sheep, goats, cattle, horses, ponies, bees, pigeons, mules, ducks, geese, chickens, minks, skunks, foxes, rabbits, buffalo, deer, llamas, alpacas, ostriches, emus, or any other livestock, farm animal, or poultry, or any wild or vicious animals dangerous to mankind in the Village.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby ordered to be published in pamphlet form by the Princeville Village Clerk and said Clerk is ordered to keep at least three (3) copies hereof available for public inspection in the future and in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is in addition to all other ordinances on the subject and shall be construed therewith excepting as to that part in direct conflict with any other ordinance, and in the event of such conflict, the provisions hereof shall govern.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and ten (10) day period of publication in the manner provided by law.




